5. Sunscreen Use and Authorization

I understand that I am to apply sunscreen to my child before dropping him/her off to attend a Polestar summer camp program.

I also understand that it is my option to authorize Polestar staff to apply sunscreen, that I provide, to my child as needed throughout the day when he/she is attending an Polestar summer program. If I have authorized its use, it is my responsibility to supply Polestar camp personnel with an unexpired bottle/tube of sunscreen, labeled with my child’s first and last name.

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6. Dress Code Policy

Students attending a Polestar summer camp program will be issued one shirt on their first day of camp. For safety and other reasons, students must wear their camp shirt and athletic closed-toe shoes every day of camp.

7. Splash Days

On a splash day, students can either bring their bathing suits to change into, or they can wear them under their clothes. Closed-toe shoes are still required during the camp day, but sandals may be worn when walking to and from the water slide or to and from the beach. Remember, send a towel and water bottle for your camper.

8. Absence Policy

Tuition fees for Polestar camps are paid in consideration for a place in Polestar summer programs. No refunds or credits accrue to students who are absent during the weeks that they are enrolled in Polestar camp.

9. Refund Policy

No refunds will be considered beyond 72 hours after the RRA and payments are submitted. A full refund, of paid but unearned fees, will be provided if a camp is cancelled by Polestar for any reason.

10. Hold Harmless Release

I hereby assume all risks of injury or illness for my child that may occur while participating in any Polestar summer camp activity, or using facilities or equipment owned or rented by Polestar or ECDS. I will in no way hold Polestar and/or ECDS, its agents, contractors, employees, or its successors and assigns liable for lost or damaged belongings or injury that my child may sustain while involved in a Polestar summer program based at ECDS.

11. Financial Responsibility

I assume financial responsibility for my child and agree to meet all financial obligations when they are due.

12. Understandings & Agreements

I understand that if, for any reason, it is found to be in the best interest of Polestar, Polestar reserves the right to nullify an accepted RRA for a Polestar summer camp program. If Polestar nullifies an RRA, all advance fees paid but not earned will be refunded and any balance due will be waived.
